

PETER PAN

PART 1

NARRATOR:

(introduction) Wendy, John and Michael Darling live in London. These children love the story "Peter Pan" very much, especially Wendy, the oldest child, who doesn't want to grow up.

One-night Peter Pan comes into the children's house through the window to take them to Neverland, a place where people never grow up.

Tinkerbell, a little friend of Peter's, splatters Wendy and her brothers with magic dust, and they fly away over London.

THINKERBELL: I love the story "Peter Pan"

WENDY: I want to be a child forever

PART 2

NARRATOR: The Darling children and their new friends are flying happily over the houses of Neverland when Captain Hook in his pirate ship, attacks them. He shoots a cannonball at them, but fortunately, this pirate does not hurt them.

PETER PAN: -Oh, no!. It's Captain Hook!

NARRATOR: Peter Pan thinks it is better to take the children to his hiding place, so he asks Tinkerbell to help. But Thinkerbell is jealous because she has notices that Peter Pan is very special to Wendy.

PETER PAN: Let's go to my hideout!

NARRATOR: Thinkerbell tells the Lost Boys, some kids who live in a tree with Peter Pan, that Wendy is not a good person. They hit Wendy, and Peter Pan gets angry at Thinkerbell. And, while Michael and John go out looking for adventure with the lost Boys, he shows Wendy his town, Neverland.

BOYS: We always like adventure!

PART 3

NARRATOR: In their adventure the children see many Indians all around. They are angry because they cannot find Tiger Lily, their Princess. They think the children are hiding their princess, so they take them to prison.

INDIAN: Where's our princess Tiger Lily?

NARRATOR: Peter Pan and Wendy continue flying over Neverland. When they go to Skull Rock, they see that Captain Hook and his mate Smee have Princess Tiger Lily. She is the prisoner! So, Peter Pan goes to help her and fights Captain Hook. The bad captain falls into the lagoon, and Smee saves him from a crocodile that wants to eat him.

PETER PAN: Where is Peter Pan hiding place?

PART 4

NARRATOR: Peter Pan and Wendy go with Princess Tiger Lily to her town. When the Indians see Tiger Lily, they ask her to tell them what is really happening. She explains everything, so the Indians untie the Children and they start to party by dancing in circles. They are more excited than ever.

INDIAN: Look! Our princess is here!

WENDY: I'm more excited and happier than ever!

NARRATOR: While Thinkerbelle watches the celebration from the distance, Mr. Smee captures her, and takes her to Captain Hook.

Mr. SMEE: I'm angry at Peter.

NARRATOR: Hook promises Thinkerbelle to take Wendy away from Peter Pan with the condition that Thinkerbelle tells Hook where Peter Pan's hiding place is. Thinkerbelle is so jealous that she points to Peter Pan's hideout on Captain Hook's map.

PART 5

NARRATOR: Captain Hook starts laughing at Thinkerbelle and captures her inside a lantern. Then, he goes with his pirate friends to Peter Pan's hideout and catches Wendy and the boys. The pirates tie them up and take them as prisoners to Hook's ship.

But before going to the ship, Captain Hook leaves a present for Peter Pan. It's a wrapped box with a beautiful ribbon. It says: "To Peter with all my love. From Wendy, "Hook knows Peter likes getting presents for Wendy.

CAPTAIN HOOK: I have to leave this "present" for Peter Pan!

PART 6

NARRATOR: Captain Hook's present for Peter Pan is not exactly a present. It is a bomb! Thinkerbelle can listen to Hook's conversation and now she knows he wants to kill Peter Pan.

THINKERBELLE: Oh! It wasn't a present. It was a bomb!

NARRATOR: Thinkerbelle admits her error and wants to help Peter. She has to escape so she moves vigorously in the lantern, until it falls down and breaks. She flies to the hideout immediately.

THINKERBELL: I prefer helping Peter Pan. I have to scape!

NARRATOR: In the hideout. She finds Peter opening the present. She hurries and takes it away from him, flying out of the hideout. Suddenly, the bomb explodes. Peter pan is out of danger.

PART 7

NARRATOR: Meanwhile, Captain Hook was on his ship. He listened to the bomb explode in the distance and he laughed happily! The children were still there as prisoners. He looked at his prisoners and asked them to become pirates. But Wendy was not scared.

WENDY: "I'm not a pirate and will never be one! Peter Pan will come and save us"!

CAPTAIN HOOK: "Not this time,"

NARRATOR: Wendy walked the plank of the ship and jumped. Hook listened for the splash but there wasn't any. Suddenly, Peter Pan appeared with Wendy in his arms. He asked his friends to fight with him against the pirates.

PETER PAN: Let's fight against the pirates!

PART 8

NARRATOR: Captain Hook went into the water. Immediately, he saw the crocodile and asked for help. The pirates jumped into a small boat but Captain Hook was already far away. The crocodile followed him and probably ate him! The other pirates disappeared after him, too.

CAPTAIN HOOK: Help! I saw the crocodile near me.

NARRATOR: Thinkerbelle sprinkled magic dust on the ship and it started to fly.

PETER PAN: "Let's go home to London, Peter said.

NARRATOR: At home, Mr. and Mrs. Darling went into the children's room and saw Wendy sleeping at the window.

WENDY: "Now I can grow up",

MR. AND MRS. DARLING: "Why are you saying that?"

WENDY: "Well, It's Peter pan. Look at this ship!"

NARRATOR: Mr. Darling was confused. He had a feeling,

MR. DARLING: I saw that ship when I was young.

NARRATOR: The end
